

## Admission at UIT

The admission to B.Tech (four year programme) shall be done by Haryana State Counseling Society (HSCS)/ National Informatics Centre (NIC), Govt. of India through Online Off Campus Counseling for academic session 2010-11. Admission to any institution will be governed by rules stated in Information Brochure of HSCS.

Universal Institute imparts instructions in the following areas of learning:

- (i) B.Tech in Electronics and Communication
- (ii) B.Tech in Computer Science & Engineering
- (iii) B.Tech in Civil Engineering
- (iv) B.Tech in Mechanical engineering

## Admission in B.Tech

### Eligibility

The candidate should have passed 10+2 examination from a recognized Board/ University with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with any one of the following subjects: (i) Chemistry, (ii) Computer Sc/ Information Sc., (iii) Bio-Technology (iv) Biology.

### Admissions under Management/NRI seats:

25 % seats of the sanctioned Intake in all the branches is reserved for Management/NRI/NRI wards. Admission to these seats will be done by the counseling at the Institute level strictly on the basis of AIEEE - 10 ranks. More information for admission in session 2010-11 will be available soon.

### Fees Chargeable

Following fees structure has been approved by State Fee Committee, Haryana for the session 2010-11.

University Charges and any other charges will be on actual basis.

### Admissions by Counseling conducted by HSCS for 75 % seats:

- Admissions shall be made on the basis of the inter se merit of AIEEE-2008 through On-line Off-Campus counseling by NIC .
- Counseling fee for B.E./B.Tech. Courses are Rs. 500/- (Non-Refundable) only & shall be deposited by the candidate through [www.hscs.org](http://www.hscs.org), in the account of Haryana State Counseling. Candidates without depositing Rs. 500/- (Non-Refundable) shall not be considered for admission for allotment of seat. Candidates are advised in their own interest to deposit counseling participation fee of Rs. 500/- (Non-Refundable) before the Registration and to check display of their fee deposited entry on "Payment Status" link on website [www.hscs.org](http://www.hscs.org).

- Registration for counseling would be done on [www.tehadmissions.gov.in](http://www.tehadmissions.gov.in). A candidate shall be allowed for change of his/her registration details on the counseling websites as and when required before locking of choices during counseling period. In case any candidate changes registration details after submission of choices, but before locking, all choices filled earlier will be initialized and all choices will be required to be filled in again.
- Locking of submitted choices is compulsory.
- There will be three phased counseling, but registration will be allowed only before first phase of counseling. No fresh registration would be allowed after first phase of counseling, so candidates willing to participate in online off-campus counseling will have to register before the first phase counseling as per the dates mentioned in "Key Dates" of DTE brochure.
- After the result of 1st phase of counseling, the candidate is required to deposit token admission fee of Rs. 20,000/- in the account of Haryana State Counseling Society through [www.hscs.org](http://www.hscs.org), failing which the candidate shall not be considered for subsequent phases of counseling and would be out of counseling procedure. The deposition of token admission fee will enable the candidate to upgrade the allotted seat in 2nd & 3rd phase of counseling, if seats are available as per candidate's priority. Same procedure shall be followed for 2nd & 3rd phase of counseling.
- After the result of 3rd phase of counseling and deposition of token admission fee, the candidate shall report in the allotted centre alongwith the provisional allotment letter generated from the website alongwith all requisite documents/certificates/testimonials and password as per dates mentioned in "Key Dates". The Joining shall be deemed to be confirmed only after online reporting by Institute in the presence of the candidate.
- After the end of the counselling period and filling of their choices, the candidates will be allotted seats in subsequent counselling, as per the process indicated earlier as per counselling schedule.
- Fulfilling eligibility for B.E/ B. Tech. w.r.t. qualification and percentage of qualifying exam, shall be proved by the candidate not at the time of seat allotment but during reporting at respective institute prior to final cut off date for admissions. A candidate may not be eligible on the 1st day of counseling but may be eligible on subsequent days of counseling due to the reasons, whatsoever. The candidate may seek admission at his/her own risk and cost and if he/she is found ineligible at the time of reporting, his/her entire dues shall be forfeited and his/her admission shall be cancelled for which he/she shall have no claim, whatsoever.
- The candidate seeking admission will submit 3 sets of his documents/ certificates/ testimonials duly attested by the Principal/ Headmaster of the school/college last attended/any gazetted officer, at the time of reporting in the Institute.
- If the University authorities are not satisfied with the character, past behavior and antecedents of a candidate, they may refuse to admit him/her in the University/ Institute.
- All the rules and regulations for submission of migration certificate by the candidates who have passed the qualifying examinations from other Universities / Boards will be applicable as per the rules of the concerned university.

Ragging in educational institutions is banned and any one indulging in ragging is likely to be punished appropriately, which may include expulsion from the institution, suspension from the institution or classes for a limited period or fine with a public apology. The punishment may also take the shape of (i) withholding scholarships or other benefits, (ii) debarring from representation in events, (iii) withholding results, (iv) suspension or expulsion from hostel or mess, and the like. If the individual committing or abetting ragging are not/cannot be identified, collective punishment can be awarded to act as a deterrent.

The following will be termed as the act of ragging: any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act, which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student(s), indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in fresher or junior student(s) or

asking the student(s) to do any act or perform something, which such student(s) will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

## **Admission in B.Tech 2nd Year (Lateral Entry)**

### **Eligibility**

Candidates must have passed Diploma in Engineering / Technology course of a duration of 3 years or more (after 10) or 2 years (after 10+2) from Haryana Board of Technical Education or its equivalent with at least 60% marks in the aggregate OR should be a pass in BSc. Degree of minimum three year duration from a recognized university with mathematics as a subject, with 60% marks in aggregate.

### **Admissions under Management/NRI seats:**

25 % seats of the sanctioned Intake in all the branches is reserved for Management/NRI/NRI wards. Admission to these seats will be done by the counseling at the Institute level strictly on the basis of OLET (LEET - 08) rank. More information for admission in session 2008-09 will be available soon.

### **Fees Chargeable**

Fees charged will be same as that of B. Tech (I year entry)

## **Admissions by Counseling conducted by HSCS for 75 % seats:**

### **(10% additional seats in each branch are reserved for Lateral entry in 2nd Year)**

- Admissions shall be made on the basis of the inter se merit of OLET (LEET – 2008) through On-line Off-Campus counselling by NIC.
- Online entrance test fee for OLET(LEET)-2008 is Rs. 500/- (non-refundable) and shall be deposited by the candidate through [www.hscs.org](http://www.hscs.org), in the account of Haryana State Counseling Society. Candidate without depositing Rs. 500/- (Non-Refundable) OLET(LEET)-2008 fee shall not be considered for online entrance test. Candidates have to deposit the OLET fee on [www.hscs.org](http://www.hscs.org) before OLET registration on: [www.onlinetesthry.nic.in](http://www.onlinetesthry.nic.in).
- The inter-se merit of OLET (LEET) - 2008 will be displayed on the [www.onlinetesthry.nic.in](http://www.onlinetesthry.nic.in).
- The counseling fee of Rs. 500/- (Non-Refundable) shall be deposited by the candidate through [www.hscs.org](http://www.hscs.org), in the account of Haryana State Counseling Society before counseling. Candidates without depositing Rs. 500/- (Non-Refundable) shall not be considered for counseling and for further allotment of seat.
- Candidates are advised to check their OLET(LEET)-2008 fee and counseling participation fee deposition entry on "Payment Status" link on website [www.hscs.org](http://www.hscs.org).
- Registration for counseling would be done on [www.tehadmissions.gov.in](http://www.tehadmissions.gov.in). A candidate shall be allowed for change of his/her registration details on the counseling websites as and when required before locking of choices during counseling period. In case any candidate changes registration details after submission of choices, but before locking, all choices filled earlier will be initialized and all choices will be required to be filled in again.
- Locking of submitted choices is compulsory.

- There will be three phased counseling, but registration will be allowed only before first phase of counseling. A candidate may not be eligible on the 1st day of counseling but may be eligible on subsequent days of counseling due to the reasons, whatsoever. The candidate may seek admission at his/her own risk and cost and if he/she is found ineligible at the time of reporting, his/her entire dues shall be forfeited and his/her admission shall be cancelled for which he/she shall have no claim, whatsoever.
- The candidate seeking admission will submit 3 sets of his documents/ certificates/ testimonials duly attested by the Principal/ Headmaster of the school/college last attended/any gazetted officer, at the time of reporting in the Institute.
